1. Jeio Rose NV, Italy - Delicate pink colour with fine & persistent bubbles. Elegant & complex nose with rose notes, hints of fresh fruit, citrus & lychees. Harmonious with a dry & long lasting finish.

4. El Muro DO Carinena Macabeo 2008, Spain - Fun, fruity white with refreshing fruit flavours. Peach and apple fruit from the Airen and Macabeo are lifted by the aromatic, grapey notes from the Moscatel.

7. Argento Pinot Grigio 2008, Argentina - This elegant Pinot Grigio offers delicate, floral aromas and tropical fruits. Light and clean with ripe pineapple and peach flavours, notes of sweet spice and a bright crisp finish.

8. Saam Mountain Paarl Chenin Blanc 2008, South Africa - Rich tropical aromas of pear, guava and ripe yellow stone fruits jump out of the glass from this Chenin Blanc. The abundance of flavours carries through on the well-structured palate.

10. The Paddock Chardonnay/Semillon 2008, Australia - Juicy, sun-packed Australian wine with peach & tropical fruit on the nose. The palate keeps up the exotic theme with refreshing peach & pineapple notes with some crisp lemon acidity on the finish

12. El Muro DO Carinena Garnacha Rosado 2008, Spain - Great summer drinking and packed with summer goodness! Dry but generous on the palate.

13. Conto Vecchio Pinot Grigio Blush 2008, Italy - The nose is fruity, slightly floral and pleasant; particularly crisp and balanced palate.

14. Wandering Bear Zinfandel Rose 2008, USA - Drier than many white Zinfandels, this nevertheless has plenty of raspberry and watermelon fruit flavours. Juicy and light, it has a refreshing bright acidity on the finish. Strawberries and Cream.

15. El Muro DO Carinena Tempranillo/Garnacha 2008, Spain - This is the sort of wine Spain excels at: vibrant with crunchy ripe fruits, soft rounded tannins and just a twist of pepper on the finish.

16. Piropo Malbec 2008, Argentina - Intense aromas of black stone fruit mingled with notes of chocolate & sweet spice from gentle oak aging. Blackberry & blackcurrant flavours lead to a long finish complemented by soft tannins.

17. Katnook Founders Block Coonawarra Cabernet Sauvignon 2005, Australia - A richly layered palate structure of ripe fruit, soft oak and fine tannins are the key features of this Coonawarra Cabernet. Ripe savoury dark berries, hints of mulberries and spicy plum fruit combine with sweet vanilla and bright, fresh acidity on the finish.

18. Valdivieso Reserve Pinot Noir 2007, Chile - Bright attractive red colour. Intense fruit showing strong cassis and dark cherry aromas. Full bodied yet lively, being round and smooth, with good acidity, and a long flavoursome finish.

19. Castillo de Clavijo Rioja Crianza 2004, Spain - Aromas of good intensity and smooth complexity of ripe red-berries, spices and vanilla. In the mouth it is balanced and pleasant, with body, elegant and harmonious on the palate, with a long finish in which the very ripe fruit flavours dominate, with a reminder of its time in the barrel coming through.

20. Villa dei Fiori Montepulciano d'Abruzzo 2007, Italy - Intense ruby red, light violet shades, full bodied, robust, dry, soft, harmonious, velvety, slightly tannic.

21. Saam Mountain Paarl Shiraz 2006, South Africa - A dark plum, black berry and spicy nose, typical of the Agter Paarl region. The intensity of the fruit is carried on to the palate where it fills one's mouth with juicy tannins and ripe, dark, sweet fruit, rounded off by a dash of well managed oak. The aftertaste is long and integrated.

22. Saint Etalon Merlot Vin de Pays d'Oc 2007, Southern France - Deep ruby colour. Elegant nose of ripe berries fruit. Well balanced, round and smooth on the palate.
